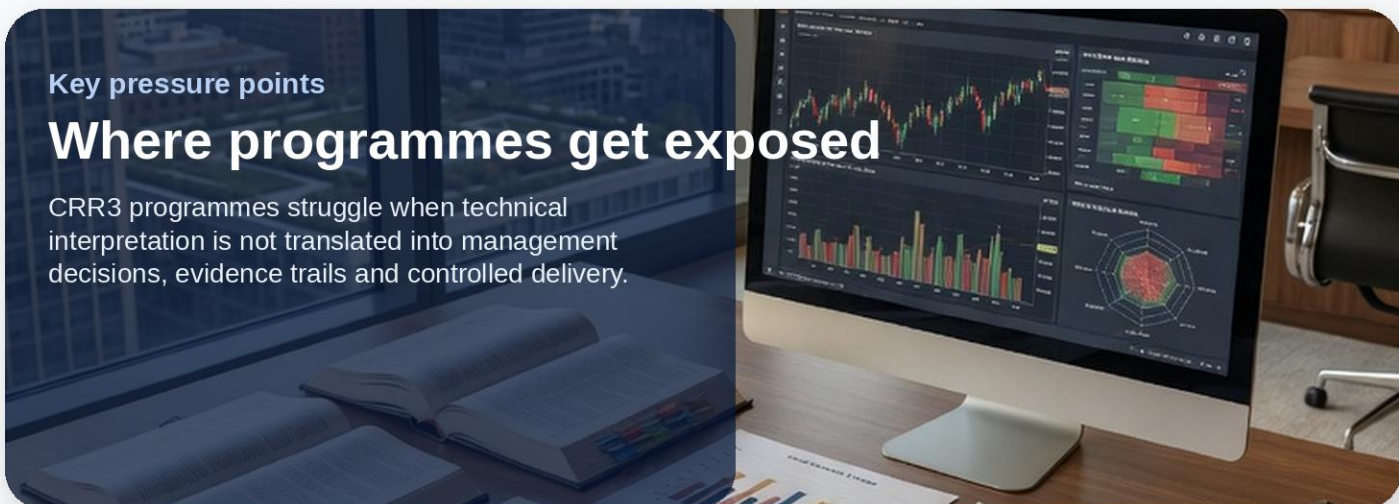

Capital and RWA view

Management needs day-one, transitional and fully loaded impact by portfolio and business line—not one headline number.

Reporting and disclosures
